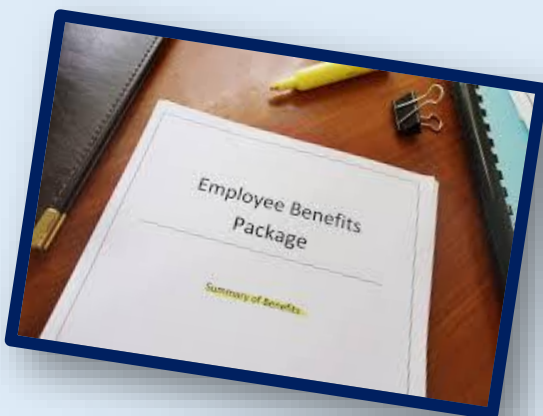




Compensation and Benefits
